## **ADVANCE NOTICE OF CHANGES TO BARINGS GLOBAL AGRICULTURE FUND (the "Fund")**

Dear Investor,

We are writing to inform you of changes to the Fund, in which you are invested.

With effect from 31 October 2024 (the "Effective Date"), we will be changing the Fund's target benchmark. Details of the changes are set out in full within the Appendix of this letter.

There will be no change to the nature or purpose of the Fund, or its risk profile, as a result of the changes.

The changes do not require shareholder approval and you do not need to take any action; however, we encourage you to read this letter as it contains important information about your investment.

### **1. Rationale for the changes to the Fund's target benchmark**

The Fund's target benchmark is currently the DAXglobal® Agribusiness (Total Net Return) Index ("DAXglobal Index"), which is referenced in its investment objective.

We have been reviewing the chosen benchmarks for a number of our funds and have decided to change the target index of the Fund to the MSCI All Country World Index (ACWI) Net Total Return Index ("ACWI Index"). The benchmark has been selected as it tracks the performance of large and mid-cap representation across developed and emerging market countries and better reflects the Fund's portfolio. The ACWI Index is currently used by many other funds in the Fund's Morningstar Natural Resources peer group.

### **2. The changes**

From the Effective Date, the Fund's target benchmark and investment objective will be updated to reference the ACWI Index. Full details of the changes are set out in a side-by-side comparison at the Appendix of this letter. There will be no change to the Fund's investment policy or strategy.

***Please note that the way in which the Fund is managed will be otherwise unchanged and its risk profile will be substantially the same.***

### **3. Costs**

Barings will bear any costs, such as legal and administrative costs associated with the changes described in this letter.
